FRANCE STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

VISA APPLICATION FORM : Complete and sign the visa application form, available on the website of the French consulate.

VALID PASSPORT: Ensure your passport is valid for at least three months beyond your intended departure date and has a minimum of two blank pages for visa stamps.

PASSPORT-SIZED PHOTOS : Provide recent passport-sized photos adhering to student visa photo requirements.

PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE : Present a formal acceptance letter from a recognized educational institution in France, confirming your enrollment in a full-time program.

PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESOURCES
Demonstrate financial capability to cover tuition fees, living expenses, & other costs. This can be substantiated with bank statements, scholarship letters, or a financial guarantee from a sponsor.

PROOF OF ACCOMMODATION : Showcase your accommodation plans in France, whether through a housing certificate from your university or a rental agreement.

PROOF OF LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY : If your course is in French, provide evidence of your proficiency in the French language.

TRAVEL INSURANCE AND AIR ITINERARY : Purchase travel insurance covering a minimum of €30,000 for medical expenses and repatriation.

SCHOLARSHIP DOCUMENTS : If you've been awarded a scholarship, provide relevant documentation verifying your scholarship details.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE & COVERING LETTER : Craft a compelling statement of purpose outlining your study plans, motivation for studying in France, and career goals.

LOR & MOI LETTER : LORs endorse qualifications and character, while "MOI Letters" specify language or instruction methods in education.

APOSTILLE & TRANSLATION DOCUMENTS : Apostille authenticates documents for international recognition, while translation documents convert texts for cross-linguistic communication.

CAMPUS FRANCE NOC LETTER : It is issued by Campus France for visa applications, confirming acceptance into a French educational institution.
